Swimming Victoria Annual Registration 2018/2019

EFFECTIVE: 1st July 2018 – 30th June.2019 All members are required to pay an annual registration fee to our governing body, Swimming Victoria. (This includes insurance). All swimmers, coaches, committee members and officials must reregister each year in order to have current membership coverage so as not to be at risk. Unregistered swimmers are not permitted to compete in any sanctioned SVI meet. Swimmers can register as a competitive swimmer or a recreational swimmer. Swimming Fees -2019 Term 1

FRIENDLY REMINDER

Fees are due the first week of term. PLEASE. You will receive an invoice shortly.

\$12 per session, paid as a term fee upfront. The number of weeks in a term is determined by the Victorian School term.

Families and multiple session swimmers please note the change in Club Fee structure. Fees are based on family sessions being swum and no longer on amount of children swimming. The first and second session for the week are charged at full price (\$12 per session) The third and every subsequent session, for that member or any other family member is charged at \$6 per session.

One session/week = \$12 - Two sessions/week = \$24 - Three sessions/week = \$30 - Four sessions/week = \$36
